


# Restart Wage Subsidy

Helping you to employ mature age workers



The Restart wage subsidy can support your business to hire eligible mature age job seekers for 12 months or more.

## What is it?



The subsidy is a payment up to \$10,000 (GST inclusive) which you may receive from the time your new employee starts work. It can help your business with the costs of recruitment, including training and wages for your new employee/s.

## Am I an eligible employer?



To be eligible your business must:

- be a legal entity with an Australian Business Number
- have not previously received a Restart wage subsidy for the same job seeker and
- not be an Australian, state or territory government agency.

## Who can I hire to receive this wage subsidy?



An eligible job seeker:

- is 50 years of age or older, and
- has been on income support for six months or more.

The person you employ cannot have an outstanding workers' compensation claim against you or be an immediate family member.

## How will the subsidy be paid?



Your business can receive up to \$6,500 (GST inclusive) when you employ an eligible job seeker for at least 30 hours per week. Pro-rata payments starting from \$3,250 (GST inclusive) are available for part-time work, between 15-29 hours per week.

A bonus payment of up to \$3,500 (GST inclusive) is also available for full-time employment of 30 hours or more which lasts the full 12 months, making the total subsidy up to \$10,000 (GST inclusive).

The amount you receive will vary depending on the hours worked by the employee, but to receive a wage subsidy, the employee must work a minimum of 15 hours per week.
